- God is faithful.
 - He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it. 1 Thessalonians 5:24
- God is generous.
 - Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places. Ephesians 1:3
- It all belongs to God.
 - "But who am I, and what is my people, that we should be able thus to offer willingly? For all things come from you, and of your own have we given you.

- We serve a God of abundance. We will operate with an abundance mindset, not a scarcity mindset.
 - And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work. 2 Corinthians 9:8
 - Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. Philippians 4:6-7

 - As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life. 1 Timothy 6:17-19

- Development involves inviting someone to join what God is doing not just asking for money.
 - So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise." John 5:19
